But referred the matter to a Jury.

Answer: But late of this County was attached to answr unto James Barry in an action on the 29. day of April in the year of our Lord 1689 before the said Thomas Cool barrister late of this County, two £100. the one to be paid in the mth of May 1689 upon demand, and other £100 the year next ensuing to be paid by the said James as will appear in Court by Evidence, the one sum being demanded of the said James according to Bargain the said Thomas being regarding his promise assumption but fraudulently inducing the pl. to stand of the said £100 according to Bargain although often thereunto required - Paid delayed to pay and still delaying whereupon the pl. saith he is committit and has damages to value of 700 pounds of tobacco and thereupon brings his suit of Recd Edward Jones. Jones sworne upon James Barry's account, viz. Thomas Eyre John Dorman Saml Northamton John Blasf.

Answer: Somerset County Sir William Hobson late of Somerset County was attached to answr unto Thomas Fenwick of a p^t of trespass upon the Cap. ex. --

I and wherupon the sd Thomas Fenwick by Sir George Scott his attorney Complaineth that whereas the said William the 29. day of April in the year of our Lord 1689 at Monmore within this County the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the sd Thomas one good sufficient sum being in Consideration that the sd Thomas acquitt one Richard Hobson Esq. of John Copper and deliver to him a certain Bill which he had of one Copper defrauded whereby the said Copper was indebted to him the sd Thomas and audit of him the sd William for pay. did affix upon him selfe, and to the said Thomas then and theri faithfully, premis that he the sd William, his C^r to the sd Thomas when he should be therunto required would well and truly rendent and pay, notwithstanding the sd William, his promise and assumption aforesd regarding but minding and fraudulently misdealing the sd Thomas in this behalf craftily and subtilly to defraud and deface the sd C^r to the sd Thomas hath not paid although the said William to do the same by the sd Thomas, afterwards the day and place and was paid.
