

March 15 1689 The Deposition of Thomas Cook: Being saide that when Augustus Leggin  
 w<sup>th</sup> Henry Lyne they came to agreement before by all, and w<sup>th</sup> Lyne paid him two pounds of tobacco  
 more than his demand, whereupon w<sup>th</sup> Lyne said, now Thomas, its me you for my two pounds of  
 tobacco and further your deponent sayeth not. Thomas: Cook.

Sworn to before w<sup>th</sup> Edmund Howard. of Pool. John: West. J<sup>r</sup>. Clerk. Cur. Quil: Court.

March 15 1689 The deposition of Thomas Cook: Being saide, being the attorney of w<sup>th</sup> Henry  
 Lyne, sued John Lohr & Charles in his suits for two hundred and odd pounds of Lark's duty  
 Bill, which Bill of the said Cook had in custody. Lohr & Charles at Court came forward and promised  
 payment if I would withdraw the auct<sup>r</sup> debt and charges, whereupon I withdrew the action  
 being attorney for w<sup>th</sup> Henry Lyne and further sayeth not. Thomas: Cook.
