At which time he ought and unjustly detaineth.

And whereupon the said Stephen by Color Doull his attorney, saith that the sd Matthew the 14th day of January the year of our Lord 1688. at Moncton within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Bill Obligated unto the said Stephen with the seal of the said Matthew signed brought into Court, the date whereof the day and year aforesaid and acknowledged himself to be bound to the sd Stephen in the sd two Negroes and five pounds in good to be pd to the sd Stephen, the one by last of Marie Eufonia the date and the other of y^e town of Barbados, and the sd five pounds in good to be delivered at his returne from the said Barbados, all which severall payments, well and truly to be made the sd Matthew bound him self finally by the sd Bill, although the sd Matthew, the sd two Negroes, and five pounds in good, according to the tenor of the sd Bill, although he saith the same to the sd Stephen hath not rendered, but hath hitherto denied and doth still deny to
