the year 1689. in the sum of 629. pounds of port as debt were plainly appear by two certain writing
under the hand & and seals of the dft and bws in Court produced, but the dft dlt regarding his promise
of assumption but fraudulently intending the pte to deivne in the sum of 1229. pounds of tobacco and also in
the sum of 629 pounds of port, but hys wchted to pay and still dole wchted, although often remonstrated
required, whereupon the pte saith he is damnified, and had damage to his value and cost of 9000 pounds of
tobacco and thereupon brings his suit. a/c Quir. Edward Gower.

Somerset ss. Joseph Taylor was summond to afforw mle Cap Henry Smith in a place of
afforw of the dft. one and thd Henry by his Attorney Peter Paul, saith that in June last
the d^d Henry Brown bound for the said Joseph to the Lord Baltimore for the delivery of the two shillings
of pte. but the said Joseph hys not paid the d^d Bills of Exchange according to the summe of the said
bond given in that behalfe, whereby the d^d Henry is liable to be sued for the penality of the said
bond, therfore desirous to have scurity of the d^d Joseph for to pay the said Henry: Harmolett from
any damage that shall accrue by the non payment of the said Bills of Exchange and thereupon

Somerset County ss. Richard Blundell was attested to afforw mle William Sharp of a place of afforw
upon the Cap of. afforw; and whereupon the d^d William by his Attorney complaineth
that the d^d Richard the 8th day of October in the year of our Lord 1689. at Monocci within the Jurisdiction
of this Court was indebet to the said William in the sum of twelve hundred and forty two pounds of tobacco
for his two months accomodation at the house of the said William, and other goods sold and delivred as pte
and the d^d Richard to the affm in manner aforesd being morded the d^d Richard in Consideration did affm upon
him selfe and to the d^d affm, then and there faithfully promise that the d^d Richard the sum of 1243. pounds
of tobacco to the said affm. when he should be the same requested would well and truly to about and pay.
Nevertheless the said Richard his promise and assumption did not regarding but minded and fraudulently, intencion
him the said William in this behalfe craftily and subtilly to deivne and defraud the said sum of 1243 -
pounds of tobacco. to the said affm. hys not paid although the said Richard to do the same, by the said
affm afterwards was requested but hys hitherto refusd and dole still refus to the damage of the said
affm of 1800. pounds of tobacco, and thereof he brings his suit. a/c
