So help you God.

The Oath for Constables. Ordered to be taken as followeth  
You shall swear that you shall well and truly serve their Ma<sup>ties</sup> in the Office  
of Constables you shall see and cause that their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Peace be well and  
duly kept according to the Statutes you shall arrest all such persons as in  
your presence shall commit or make any riot or affray or breach of their  
Ma<sup>ties</sup> Peace you shall do your best endeavour upon complaint to you made  
to apprehend all felons, barretors, rycors or persons riotously assembled  
and if any such offenders shall make any such resistance with force you shall  
have the aid and ay shall pursue them untill they be taken, you shall do  
your best endeavour. Thus and they be duly raised and pursued against  
murderers thieves and other felons or fugitive servants, and that the  
Laws and Statutes and such other good persons touching within your limits  
be duly put in execution at your County Court, you shall present all offences done  
against the severall Acts made for the suppressing of drunkenness and also present  
make of all bloodshed affrayes Outryes rycors and other offences committed against  
their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Peace within your limits, you shall well and truly execute all precepts  
and warrants to you directed from the Justices of the Peace of this County, or higher  
Officers and you shall well and truly according to your knowledge power and  
ability execute all things belonging to a Constable so long as you shall  
continue in this Office. So help you God.
