XLVI.

All Bills reported to this House by a Committee shall be printed in bill form; but bills of a local character shall not be printed unless ordered by a special vote of the House.

XLVII.

Reports of Committees on subjects of a private or local nature shall not, in future, be entered in extenso, on the Journal; but the favorable or unfavorable character only, of such Reports, shall be placed on the Journal.

XLVIII.

The House shall be resolved into a Standing Committee of the Whole on the condition of the State, if required by seven Members; which Committee may originate Bills or Resolu-
