A bill to incorporate the Baltimore Rifle Target Shooting Association;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill to incorporate the Baltimore and Havana Steamship company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Washington county to assume a just proportion of the debt assumed by the Mayor and Councilmen of the town of Hagerstown, known as the McCausland debt;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill to incorporate the Hagerstown Lumber and Coal company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill to change the name of William Baker Lowdermilk, of Cumberland, Allegany county, to Will. H. Lowdermilk;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill to protect timber of any kind whatsoever in Dorchester county;
