3d:

4th:

A. I was, sir.

12th:

A. I heard no such conversation.

13th:

A. No, sir; I think not.

14th:

A. No, sir; there is one word left out; we administered the oath of allegiance and administered the following form with it which says, "You will answer all such questions as shall be propounded to you, touching your right to registration and voting."

15th:

A. The first two days I think we did not, but after that we did.

16th:

A. I think there was one or two through mistake; the books will show.
