2d.

3d.

A. Did not vote because I wasn't registered, would have voted full Democratic ticket, including Mr. Franklin.

4th. Waived.

A. I didn't know anything about that.

2d:

A. No, s r, I did not.

3d:

A. No, sir.

4th:

A. No, I don't think I ever did.

5th.

A. I didn't know anything about, nor said anything about it.
