So much as relates to the Naval Academy, Reconstruction and Foreign Relations to the committee on Federal Relations.

So much as relates to Governor Bradford to a Special committee of five.

Which was read and adopted.

The Chair appointed as Select committee, in relation to Governor Bradford, Messrs. Trail, Ohr, Turner, Lansdale and Vickers.

Mr. Ohr, from the Select committee, reported a bill to incorporate the Workingmen's Co-operative Store of Cumberland;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Also, a bill incorporating the Allegany Vine-Growing Manufacturing Association;

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Ohr, from the Select committee, reported a bill for the protection of Sheep in Allegany county;

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Agriculture.

Mr. Ohr presented the petition of J. Welsh and others of Allegany county;

Referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

On motion of Mr. Ohr,

Leave was granted Messrs. Ohr, Tome and Lansdale, to report a bill to pay Whitney, Medeary and Cushing for books for Registration of Births, Marriages and Deaths.

On motion of Mr. Ohr,

Leave was granted the committee on Judiciary, to report a bill to repeal section 133 of article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments."

On motion of Mr. Tome,

Leave was granted the committee on Finance, to report a bill to refund to E. A. Small and others, amounts erroneously paid into the Treasury.

On motion of Mr. Tome,

Ordered, That when the Senate adjourns to-day it stands adjourned till Monday next at 12 o'clock.
