Section 16, line 4: After the word "logs," insert the words "boards or other lumber;"

Section 16, line 4: After the word "other," add the word "convenient;"

Section 17, line 3; Strike out the word "treble;"

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Vickers submitted the following amendment:

Section 7, line 17: After word "non-resident," insert "he may be proceeded against by warrant from a Justice of the Peace, and by presentment or indictment in the Circuit court of Cecil or Harford counties, and if convicted, be fined or imprisoned in the discretion of the court;"

Which was read and adopted.
