I heard that your band was going to have a concert at Washington. I hope that they will try to do their very best. O what a great thing it is to be a good player in a band! We have a very fine school. I have attended two-quarters, and I expect to go to the third one. I sing bass and carry my part very well. I am very thankful to Mrs. L. and Mr. Deems for their kind instruction to me, I have a very good home. I like Mr. and Mrs. W. very much indeed. They are very kind to me.
