Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.

A bill to incorporate the Pocahontas Manufacturing company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Leave was granted the committee on Finance, to report a bill to compensate Hon. E. F. Chambers.

The bill authorizing the Governor, Comptroller, and Treasurer, to sell the Bank Stock standing to the credit of

the Free Schools of this State, and invest the proceeds; Was read the second time, ordered to be printed, and made

the order of the day for to-morrow, at 1 o'clock. The Senate adjourned.
