

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to incorporate the Globe Express company.

On motion of Mr. Nairne,

Leave was granted the Worcester county delegation to report a bill to incorporate the town of Snow Hill, in Worcester county.

On motion of Mr. Leaverton,

Leave was granted the Talbot county delegation to report a bill to change the name of Rufus Henry Greenhawk to that of Rufus Henry Love.

On motion of Mr. Smith, of Frederick,

Leave was granted the committee on Internal Improvements to report a bill directing the County Commissioners of Frederick county to levy a sum of money on the taxable property of said county for the purpose of building the two bridges over the Monocacy river, destroyed at the time of the battle of the 9th of July, 1864.

Leave was granted the committee on Education to report a bill to authorize the School Commissioners of Frederick county to pay to Jonas Urner and Nicholas Norris, two of the Trustees of Primary School District No. 53, in said county, a sum of money advanced by them for the support of the school in said district in the years 1863 and 1864, during the time of their trusteeship.
