Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to amend section 14, article 39, Code Public General Laws, entitled, "Ferries."

On motion of Mr. Cook,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to exempt a certain amount of property from execution.

On motion of Mr. Hambleton,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the Maryland Military Institute.

On motion of Mr. Mittag,

Leave was granted the Washington county delegation, to repor a bill to prevent the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors on or near the line of the Washington county Railroad;

Also, leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the Hagerstown Lumber and Coal company.
