Leave was granted the committee on Colored Population to report a bill to repeal sub-section 2 of an act passed on the second March 1864, Chapter 109, relating to the Competency of witnesses, and to substitute a new section therefore; and to repeal a part of the substitute section 42 of the Code of Public General Laws, passed on the eleventh of February, 1864, chapter 105, relating to the same.

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill to amend "An act entitled, an act to amend sections 30 and 32 of article 5 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Appeals," relating to the transmission of records and the filing of Appeal Bonds.
