Which were read and adopted, and the bill was read the second time.

Mr. Stephenson from the committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill making January Term of Circuit court of Allegany county, a Criminal Term;

Mr. Tome from the committee on Finance, to which was referred the bill in favor of L. Valentine, reported it without amendment; and,

It was read the second time.
