

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to prohibit the issuing of any license for the sale of *squirituous or fermented liquors* within three miles of either of the churches in the village of *Wolfsville, Frederick county, Maryland*, and to prevent the sale of all kinds of intoxicating drinks within the above described limits;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to add additional sections to chapter 197 passed at the January session 1852, relating to *Slaughter Creek Bridge in Dorchester county*;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to build a new City Hall;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act authorizing the trustees of the Methodist Protestant church, situated on the North West corner of *Fayette and Aisquith streets*, to sell a certain lot of ground;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to refund to *Levi Valentine and Levi Yingling* certain sums of money, erroneously paid into the State Treasury;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to authorize and require the county commissioners of Frederick county to levy a sum of money to rebuild two bridges across the *Monocacy river*;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to refund a sum of money paid into the State Treasury erroneously by *John H. Bond*, of the fifth election district of Baltimore county;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 310 of Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "*Frederick county*," and to re-enact the same with amendment;
