Also, the following House bill:

An act to incorporate Eureka Lodge No. 105 of Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons of Sharpsburg, in Washington county;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, the following Senate bills:

An act to incorporate the Allegany Vine Growing, Manufacturing and Agricultural Association;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

An act to repeal sections 75, article 17, of the Public Local Laws, entitled Queen Anne's county; and section 1, article 17, of the supplements and re-enact the same with amendments.

An act to empower the county Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy the sum of \$250 on the taxable property of the county, to pay J. G. Strong for 100 copies of a Map of said county, which he is about to publish on the scale of one inch to the mile and which said copies are intended to be distributed among the public schools of this county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Queen Anne's county Delegation.
