

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the President and Directors of the Monumental City Fire Insurance company.

On motion of Mr. Slothower,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary, to report a bill for the relief of William Watson, a Lunatic.

On motion of Mr. Barron,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary, to report a bill entitled, an Act to add an additional section to the Public Local Code, entitled "Baltimore city" to punish the carrying of concealed Weapons.

On motion of Mr. Buhrman,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary, to report a bill to repeal section 3, of article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Testamentary Laws," to come in after section 328, of said article and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also, leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the Hartford Fire Insurance company of Baltimore.

Mr. Poteet, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably an Act to authorize the Clerk of the Superior court of Baltimore city to pay to Thomas A. Kennard a sum of money due him as Clerk in said office;
