Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to prohibit the Commissioners of the several counties of the State and the City council of Baltimore from allowing extra compensation to their respective State's attorneys.

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the South Baltimore Coal Oil works.

On motion of Mr. Malone,

Leave was granted the Somerset and Worcester counties delegations to report a bill entitled, an Act for the improvement of Division street in the town of Salisbury, in the counties of Somerset and Worcester.

On motion of Mr. Rider,

Leave was granted the Somerset and Dorchester counties delegations to report a bill entitled, an Act annexing Holland's Island to Somerset county.

On motion of Mr. Valliant,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to report a bill entitled, an Act providing for a revision of the Code of Laws of the State.
