Mr. Lee, from a Select committee, reported favorably,

A bill to add an additional section to article four of the code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, entitled "Police,"

Which was read the first time;

Mr. Robinson, from a Select committee, reported favorably,

A bill to incorporate the Metropolitan Lodge, number seventeen, of the independent order of Odd Fellows, of the city of Annapolis,

Which was read the first time;

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the following bills:

A bill to incorporate the Plum-Point wharf company;

A bill to incorporate the Chester Fruit-packing company, Which were read the first time.
