Mr. Markey, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill, entitled, an Act, to repeal an act passed January session, 1865, entitled, an Act to amend article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Frederick County," and to re-enact the same with amendments;

Mr. Pennington, from a select committee, reported favorably, a bill entitled, an Act, to provide for repairing the old jail of Cecil county, or the building of a new jail, at the discretion of the County Commissioners of said county;

Mr. Hazen, from a select committee, reported favorably, a bill entitled, an Act to repeal sec ions 194, 196, 197, of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to reenact the same with amendments;
