AMENDMENTS PROPOSED,

Add additional section.

Section 10. *Be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to authorize the said corporation to go into operation until one thousand shares of stock are subscribed, and twenty-five thousand dollars paid in, and for every additional hundred thousand dollars of capital stock, fifty thousand dollars subscribed and twenty-five thousand dollars paid in.
