An Act to amend the Act of 1826, chapter 123, entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations.

An Act to make valid a certain bequest in the last will and testament of Anna Shultz, of Washington county, deceased;

An Act authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to build a new City Hall;

An Act to add additional sections to chapter one hundred and ninety-seven, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, relating to Slaughter creek bridge, in Dorchester county;

An Act to incorporate the Chesapeake Tribe, number thirty-two, Improved Order of Red Men, of Annapolis, Md;

An Act to incorporate Annapolis Lodge, number eighty-nine, of Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons:

A bill entitled, an Act supplementary to the Act of 1864, chapter 353, entitled, an Act to incorporate the President and Commissioners of the town of Cecilton;

A bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Thomas E. Dell for Supplemental Codes purchased by the State Librarian, in accordance with Joint Resolution No. 1, January session, 1865;

A bill entitled, an Act to authorize the Commissioner of the Land Office to issue a patent for certain land therein mentioned;

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 1, line 9, after the word "improvements," add the words, "as the improvements were originally valued by the said Surveyor, and without requiring the payment of any sum or sums of money upon any subsequent valuation of the improvements on the said land;"
