Which was adopted.

The bill was then read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal and re-enact sections 66, 67, 68, 69 and 70, of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of Cecil county, relating to Elkton;

Was read the second time, amended, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
