The Senate bill entitled, an Act to enfranchise the persons therein named;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Registration.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend article 21 of the Code of Public Laws, relating to Washington county, by adding thereto additional sections authorising the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to open streets and alleys in said town;
