*Worcester County*—JOHN P. MOORE, Democrat.

Mr. Moore, one of the most prominent citizens of Snow Hill, is an excellent business man, having accumulated a fortune while yet a young man. He was educated at Delaware College, and is a well read man, possessing a splendid library. He has been chairman of the Democratic State Central Committee for a number of years, and has also served as chairman of the Committees on Corporations and Executive Nominations in the Senate of 1900, to which he was elected to fill the unexpired term of Hon. John Walter Smith. He was unanimously nominated and re-elected by an increased majority to the Senate of 1902, though not even in the country at the time of nomination or election, being detained in France on account of the illness of his son. He was appointed a colonel on the Governor's staff. Mr. Moore is a Mason, and a member of the committee of the Presbyterian Church.
