Sec. 7 of Art. 3 of the Constitution of 1831 provided for the meeting of the Assembly on the first Wednesday of January, 1852, 1863, 1864, and on the same day every second year thereafter. From 1864 the sessions were limited to March 10th.

Ch. 5. Acts of 1884, provided for a Constitutional Convention, which met April 27th and adjourned September 8th. The new Constitution went into effect November 1st. The Assembly to meet on first Wednesday of January, 1885. and every two years thereafter. Compensation of members limited to four hundred dollars,
