Maryland responded promptly and patriotically to the call of the Nation, when the United States entered the great struggle, and the men and women of the State contributed to a conspicuous record in every phaze of Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Red Cross, Loan Campaigns, and in every other activity necessary to carrying the war to a successful conclusion.

To the fighting forces of the country Maryland sent, according to the figures compiled by the War Department, a total of 61,839 men, divided as follows:
