If so, did you then and there offer a ticket to the judges of election at said polls, as your ballot, and was it received or rejected? state also the name of the person printed on said ticket for State Senator, for whom yeu desired to vote; and what reason did the said judges assign for rejecting your vote, if they did so reject it?

Answer. I did attend at the polls on said day and offered my ballot to the judges of election, and it was rejected by them. I intended to vote then for Alfred Spates for State Senator. They said it was law for to swear me. I told them I had been registered, and that one oath was as good as a dozen. I did not vote.
