Interrogatory 1st. What is your name, age, occupation, residence and time of such residence?

Interrogatory 2nd. Are you, or was you acting as deputy clerk in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany county, when did you enter on service in said office, and when were you sworn as such?

Interrogatory 3rd. Did you receive from the Judges of election the poll books and ballots of the election held on the 6th day of November 1866; when did you receive them, and what disposition did you make of them, who examined them after they were received and prior to the 17th day of November 1866, and in whose presence?

Interrogatory 4th. Did you after the election on the 6th day of November 1866, at any time see the poll books and ballots of said election or either of them; if so, at what times and under what circumstances; state fully where you saw them, in what condition; and who, if any one, had them in hand and who was present?
