A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Tyson Mining Company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, an Act incorporating the Principio Manufacturing Company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Good Intent Lodge No. 99 of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, of Somerset county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections eight, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and nineteen of an Act to incorporate the Maryland Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, and to re-enact in lieu thereof sections 8, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18, as within recited ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, an Act to authorize the Trustees of the New Town Academy, in Worcester county, to sell their building and grounds, and to invest the proceeds of such sale in a building and grounds for a high school in the town of New Town ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill entitled, an Act to authorize the School Commissioners of Frederick county to pay to Jonas Urner and Mary Ann and Amos H. Norris, Executors of Nicholas Norris, two of the Trustees of the Primary School District No. 53 in said county, a sum of money advanced by them for the support of the school in said district, in the years 1863 and 1864, during the term of their trusteeship ;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Trail, Davis of Washington, and Jump.

Mr. Frazier rose to a question of privilege, and called the attention of the Senate to an article published in the Baltimore American, reflecting upon his course in relation to the bill entitled, an Act to repeal the 74th section of the 36th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the election of United States Senator.
