On motion of Mr. Stevens,

Ordered, That five hundred copies of the Militia Bill be printed for the use of the members.

Mr. Neilson moved to reconsider the vote by which the order to appoint James Treagle an additional clerk, was laid on the table;

Decided in the affirmative.
