Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to repeal sections five, six and eight, of chapter twenty-four, passed at the December session, eighteen hunhred and thirty-five, relating to a bridge across a branch of the Patapsco river, and to re-enact said sections with amendments.

Leave was granted the Committee on the Judiciary, to report a bill entitled, an Act to amend article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, in relation to Divorces, by repealing section 25, and re-enacting the same with amendments, and by adding a sub-section thereto, to be inserted in said Code after section twenty-five.

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Susquehanna Lumber Company.

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the Principio Furnace Company of Cecil county.
