

On motion of Mr. Clarke,

Leave was granted the Committee on Claims, to introduce a bill to extend the provisions of the Act of January Session, 1865, chapter 126, for the relief of certain parties indebted to the State, by extending the time for payment therein mentioned.

On motion of Mr. Hammond,

Leave was granted the Howard and Baltimore county Delegations, to introduce a bill to incorporate the Town of Ellicot's Mills, by the name of Ellicot city.

On motion of Mr. Boswell,

Leave was granted the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill, requiring agencies of foreign Insurance companies in the State, to pay a specific tax, in addition to the State license, to the Municipal Corporation or county, in which they are located.

On motions of Mr. Parsons,

Leave was granted the Somerset County delegation to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate Wicomico Lodge No. 91, of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons.

On motion of Mr. Smith,

Leave was granted the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce an Act, to change the name of Fanny Hyde Beach, to that of Fanny Tabb Brewer.
