Leave was granted the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill for the relief of S. L. Townsend, late collector of Allegany county, for Taxes erroneously paid the State of Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Davis, of Baltimore city,

Leave was granted the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to repeal certain Sections of Article 4th, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Habeas Corpus," and enact others in lieu thereof.

On motion of Mr. Coleman,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to amend the charter of the Baltimore Chrome Mining and Manufacturing Company, by empowering the said Company to increase its capital stock, or to make calls or assessments upon the present capital stock.

Leave was granted the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal the 37th 38th 39th and 40th sections of Article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled "Licenses," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
