Mr. Vickers, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill entitled, an Act to repeal chapter 127, of the Acts of 1864, entitled, an Act to add additional sections to the 44th Article of the Code of Public General laws, title, Maryland Hospital, prescribing an additional oath to be taken by the President, Vice-President and Visitors of the said Hospital, and to re-instate the former president, vice-president and visitors of the said Hospital in office;

Which was read the first time,

Mr. Vickers, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to protect Churches and church property and parsonages, and to punish trespasses on the same;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Tome, from the Select Committee, reported a bill entitled, an Act to amend the charter of the Philadelphia and Baltimore Central Rail Road Company;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Davis, in pursuance of previous notice, moved a reconsideration of the vote upon the passage of the bill entitled, an Act to provide for the selection, drawing and summoning of juries in Washington, Frederick and Carroll counties, and prescribing their qualification;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Vickers, from the Select Committee, reported a bill en-
