Mr. Nicolai upon the Committee on Corporations reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Ashland Iron Company of Baltimore County;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Carmichael from the Committee on the Judiciary reported favorably on a bill entitled, an Act for the benefit of the Library Company of the Baltimore Bar;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Nicolai from the Committee on Corporations reported favorably upon the bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, January session, 1866, entitled, an Act to incorporate the Maryland Land and Emigration Company.

Also, a bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Slaughter's Steamboat Company.
