Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to introduce an Act to repeal sections 806, 807, 808, 809, 810, 811, 812, 813, 814, 815, 816, 817, 818, 819, 820, 821 and 822, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the city of Baltimore, and the additional Articles adopted by the Act of the General Assembly, passed at the session of 1860, chapter 6; the additional sections adopted by the Act of the General Assembly at the Session of 1860, chapter 46; the additional sections adopted by the Act of the General Assembly, passed at the Session of 1864, chapter 42; the additional sections adopted by the Act of the same Session of 1864, chapter 244; and the third section of the Act of 1865, chapter 46, for the establishment of a Police force for the city of Baltimore, and to re-enact with amendments.
