Was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill entitled, an Act to change the name of Fanny Hyde Beach, to that of Fanny Tabb Brewer;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act exempting from execution and other final process of law (except distress for rent,) property in the State of Maryland, to the value of \$500.

Was read a second time and recommitted to the Committee on the Judiciary.

The bill entitled, an Act to further extend the time and provisions of the Act passed February 6th, 1864, chapter 15, and March 14th, 1864, chapter 373, relating to the payment of bounties to volunteers and drafted men of this State;
