The bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 1, 2 and 3, of chapter 43, of laws passed at January session, 1862, entitled, wild fowl, and to re-enact the same with amendments;

Was read the second time.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, being,

The bill authorizing the Baltimore City Passenger Railway Company to run their Cars on Sunday;

On motion of Mr. Neilson,

The further consideration thereof, was postponed until Friday next, the 15th inst.

The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Frostburg Hotel Company, of Frostburg;

Was read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Smith,

The rules were suspended, and

The House took up for consideration,

The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the St. George's Society, of Baltimore;

Said bill being upon its third reading,

Was then read the third time, and
