

Mr. Clarke presented the petition of Israel Norris, of Carroll county, praying the Legislature to pass a law authorizing the Comptroller and Treasurer to refund him monies paid erroneously into the Treasury;

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also, the petition of F. Steifel and 145 other citizens of 1st Election District of Baltimore county, praying the repeal of the Sunday Law now in force in this State;

Which was read and referred to Select Committee on Sunday Law.

Mr. Criswell presented the petition of William Gosnell and 65 other citizens of Carroll county against the proposed change in the lines or boundaries of said county;

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

The Speaker laid before the House the response of the Comptroller in answer to an order of the House relative to the cost of the Convention of 1864;

Which was read.
