Mr. Bixler, (the rules being suspended,) presented the petition of J. L. McPhail, claiming payment for services rendered the State in collecting of arms by appointment of Gov. A. W. Bradford;

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate the Franklin Turnpike Road Company, passed March 10th, 1828, chapter 186, by providing for an increase of tolls on said road;

Also, leave for a Special Committee composed of the Baltimore county delegation and the delegation representing the Third Legislative District of Baltimore city, to introduce a bill to incorporate the Gwinn's Falls Bridge Company of the Washington road.

Leave was granted Committee on Roads and Highways to introduce a bill to amend an Act to incorporate the Union Plank and Turnpike Road Company, passed at December Session, 1849.
