"Shall the previous question be now put?"

It was sustained.

The question then recurring upon the motion of Mr. Burche;

It was sustained,

And all further proceedings under the call were dispensed with.

On motion of Mr. Thomas,

The House adjourned until to-morrow morning at 12 o'clock.
