Mr. Gorsuch proposed the following amendment to the amendment:

Strike out "five thousand" and insert "three thousand;"

Which was rejected.

The question then recurred upon the amendment proposed by Mr. Jones;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Knott moved a reconsideration of the vote by which the amendment proposed by Mr. Calvert was adopted;
