Mr. Hammond proposed the following amendment:

Page 3, line 4, after the word "use," insert "if deemed by them expedient;"

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment:

Page 3, line 5, insert after the word "therefrom," the words "in whole or in part;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Hammond proposed the following amendment:

Sec. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the said company are authorized to connect its road with the Baltimore and Frederick Town Turnpike road, at any point between the tenth mile stone and the first toll gate west of Ellicott's city, on said last mentioned road;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Hammond proposed the following:

Strike out the word "Mills" wherever it occurs, and insert "City;"

Which was adopted.

The bill as amended was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
