

The bill entitled, an Act to amend the 43d section of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to summoning of Jurors in Baltimore county.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 65 of Article 19, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset county, relating to Justices of the Peace and constables and to amend and re-enact the same.

The bill entitled; an Act to amend and re-enact section 52, of Article 8 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the time of holding the terms of the circuit court for Cecil county ;

The bill entitled, an Act to protect persons known as hucksters in Washington and Allegany counties.

The bill entitled, an Act to authorize the Treasurer of the State of Maryland to refund to Lewis Magruder, Collector of State and county tax for 1862, for Prince George county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him.

The bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act to incorporate the Mutual Insurance Company of Allegany county, passed at December session, 1847, chapter 111, and the supplement thereto, passed at December session, 1849, chapter 385, and the Act amendatory thereof, passed at January session, 1860, chapter 309 ;

The bill entitled, an Act for the relief of Richard C. Hardesty, administrator of George W. Sherwood, deceased, late Clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore city ;

The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Annapolis Hotel Company ;

The bill entitled, an Act to lay off and locate a public road in Frederick and Carroll counties ;

The bill entitled, an Act to prevent the interruption of the navigation of the Little Annapolis river in Somerset county ;

The bill entitled, an Act to add a new Article to the Code Public Local Laws for Queen Anne's county, to build a new jail for said county, and provide means for that purpose ;
