The thirty-seventh rule was stricken out.

The thirty-eighth rule was then read and adopted.

Mr. Vickers submitted the following as a substitute for the thirty-ninth rule:

"Bills and resolutions from the House shall be open to amendment on their second or third reading;"

Determined in the affirmative.

The fortieth rule was then read and adopted.

Mr. Brodwater moved to amend rule forty-first by adding after the word "Secretary," the words "or Reading Clerk;"

Determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Henkle submitted the following amendment to rule forty-one:

Add, "by or with the consent of the Senate;"

Determined in the affirmative.

The forty-first rule as amended was then adopted.

The forty-second rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-third rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-fourth rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-fifth rule was then read and adopted.

Mr. Bowie submitted the following amendment to the forty-sixth rule:

"A Committee on Labor and Immigration to consist of five Senators;"

Determined in the affirmative.

The forty-sixth rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-seventh rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-eighth rule was then read and adopted.

The forty-ninth rule was then read and adopted.

The fiftieth rule was then read and adopted.
