The bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 20 of Article 96 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, weights and measures," and to re-enact the same with amendment;

Was read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Carmichael,

The vote by which the Senate bill entitled. an Act to repeal section 92 of Article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "crimes and punishments," sub-title kidnapping;

Was reconsidered.

The bill being upon its third reading,

Mr. Carmichael proposed the following amendments:

Amend by striking out the word "repealed" in line 8 section 1 and insert the following:

Amended and be enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 92. Every person, his counsellors, aiders or abettors, who shall be convicted of the crime of kidnapping and forcibly or fraudulently carrying or causing to be carried out of this State, any person with intent to have such person carried out of the State, shall be sentenced to the penitentiary for not less than two nor more than ten years;

Which were adopted.

The bill as amended,

Was then read a third time and passed by yeas and nays as follow:
